

Program Articulation Agreement



Addendum

This is an addendum to the English – Language Arts and Education program agreement between Grand Valley State University and Grand Rapids Community College. The program agreement is attached and made a part of this document.

Grand Valley State University and Grand Rapids Community College, hereby agree as follows:

- Due to changes in what the Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA) will qualify as an MTA math, MA 210, *Mathematics for Elementary Teachers 1*, and MA 211, *Mathematics for Elementary Teachers 2*, will no longer satisfy this requirement. An MTA math elective has been added to the program to allow students to earn the MTA.
- This change is effective Fall 2016.
