Addendum

2+2 Pre-Major Articulated Program

This is an addendum to the Exercise Science – Health Fitness Instruction program agreement between Grand Valley State University and Grand Rapids Community College. The program agreement is attached and made a part of this document.

Grand Valley State University and Grand Rapids Community College, hereby agree as follows:

- Grand Rapids Community College's course, CO 110, Introduction to Computer Information
 Systems has undergone a course pre-fix change. CO 110 shall be replaced with CIS 100,
 Introduction to Computer Information Systems. CIS 100 at Grand Rapids Community College shall
 maintain its equivalency to Grand Valley State University's course, CIS 150, Intro to Computing.
- Grand Rapids Community College's course, CO 156, Excel has undergone a course pre-fix and credit hour change. CO 156 shall be replaced with CIS 156, Excel, and will also increase to 3 credit hours. CIS 156 at Grand Rapids Community College shall maintain its equivalency to Grand Valley State University's course, CIS 231, Problem Solving Spreadsheets.
- 3. Total credits earned at Grand Rapids Community College will increase from 62 to 63 credits due to the course change outlined in Item 2.
