2+2 Pre-Major Articulated Program

This is an addendum to the Exercise Science – Health Fitness Instruction program agreement between Grand Valley State University and Grand Rapids Community College. The program agreement is attached and made a part of this document.

Grand Valley State University and Grand Rapids Community College, hereby agree as follows:


1. Grand Rapids Community College's course, CO 110, *Introduction to Computer Information Systems* has undergone a course pre-fix change. CO 110 shall be replaced with CIS 100, *Introduction to Computer Information Systems*. CIS 100 at Grand Rapids Community College shall maintain its equivalency to Grand Valley State University's course, CIS 150, *Intro to Computing*.
2. Grand Rapids Community College's course, CO 156, *Excel* has undergone a course pre-fix and credit hour change. CO 156 shall be replaced with CIS 156, *Excel*, and will also increase to 3 credit hours. CIS 156 at Grand Rapids Community College shall maintain its equivalency to Grand Valley State University's course, CIS 231, *Problem Solving Spreadsheets*.
3. Total credits earned at Grand Rapids Community College will increase from 62 to 63 credits due to the course change outlined in item 2.

Advising Notes




Programmatic Articulation Agreement




