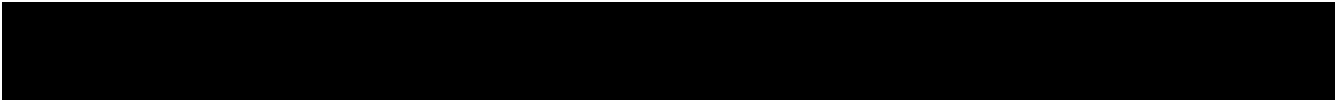
**Program Agreement**

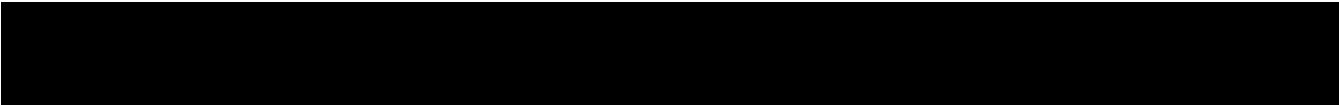
