## **Advising Notes**

### Bachelor of Science or Arts Degree Requirements at GVSU

The following requirements apply to all undergraduate students:

- 1. A minimum of 120 semester hours
- 2. A cumulative GPA of at least 2.00
- 3. Graduation major GPA of at least 2.00
- 4. General education requirements
- 5. The last 30 semester hours toward a baccalaureate degree must be earned in Grand Valley courses
- 6. A minimum of 58 semester hours must be earned at a senior (4 yr) institution
- 7. A minimum of 12 Grand Valley earned semester hours must be included in the major (six for a minor)

#### Notes:

- Admission to GVSU requires a 2.50 cumulative transfer grade point average.
- EN 102 English Composition II must be graded at a "C" or above to receive specific WRT 150 credit in transfer.
- All Issues courses must be taken at GVSU.
- Students who wish to obtain a BA must fulfill 3rd semester proficiency in a foreign language (201 level). The BS requirements are incorporated into the major requirements.
- The GVSU block tuition rate is 12-15 credits. Students will pay additional tuition for any credits over 15.
